

FOREIGNERS AUTHORIZED STAY IN PORTUGAL

The stay, residence and work in Portugal depends, in each case, on the verification of specific requirements according to the nationality country.

EUROPEAN UNION, ICELAND, LIECHTENSTEIN, NORWAY, PRINCIPALITY OF ANDORRA AND SWITZERLAND 1.

Temporary Residency Permit

(if there are particular situations the residency permit may be required without visa)

The regularly stay of EU, IS, LI, NO, AD and CH nationals in Portugal for a period longer than 3 months depends only on the application for the **Certificate of Registration for Citizens of the European Union** (CRUE).

Expiry: 5 years. After this period, the applicant may submit an application for a residence permit at SEF's;

Decision Time Limit over the request: at the moment;

Responsible Entities: Municipal Council of the respective area of residence;

Formalities: may depend on the competent Municipal Council, however in general the applicant shall present:

- Valid citizen card/ passport;
- Declaration under commitment of honnor that the applicant is employed or is self employed in Portugal;
- Declaration under commitment of honnor that the applicant has sufficient means of subsistence to live in Portugal;
- · Healt insurence;

Reunification: CRUE grants the right for family reunification;



The Visa for Residency Permit Purposes allows the foreign citizen to legaly enter Portugal in order to obtain a Residency Permit.

Expiry: 4 months (with two authorized entrances in Portuguese territory) – the entrances number shall always be confirmed in the visa;

Decision Time Limit over the request: 60 days;

Responsible Entities: the Portuguese consular post of the respective area of residence;

FOREIGN CITIZENS

HOW TO OBTAIN A VISA RESIDENCY PERMIT

Verification of the applicant's eligibility and identification of the specific visa to apply for

Coordination with the competent authorities over the fulfillment of the necessary requirements

Application analysis and collection of biometric data by the competent consular post

Visa issuance

The applicant passport is delivered at the same time as the remaining documents and returned only after visa issuance

After visa's approval this should be issued in the maximum term of 90 days

Whenever travel's date is referred in the visa application the schedule for obtaining the **residence permit** is communicated to the applicant at the consular post



The documents required for the residence visa application are:

- · Official request form;
- Passport;
- Two equal passport photos, up-to-date and with enough quality to identify the applicant;
- Valid travel insurance, allowing medical coverage, including medical emergencies and repatriation;
- Request for criminal record enquiry by the Immigration and Border Services (SEF);
- Criminal record certificate from the country of origin or the country where the applicant is residing for over a year;
- · Proof of accommodation;
- Proof of means of subsistence specific for each visa application;

At their discretion, the consular post may request for additional documents or clarifications, beyond the ones listed here.



Additionally to the previously referred documents, for each specific visa the apllicant should also presente:

D2 Visa

- · Articles of Incorporation;
- Contract or written service provider proposal for liberal professions;

D3 Visa

- Work contract, work promise;
- Declaration issued by the Portuguese Employment and Training Institute (IEFP) n/a for applications submited in 2021;
- Professional certificate (if apllicable);

D7 Visa

- Document certifying retirement amount; or
- Document certifying revenue from movable and immovable property; intellectual or financial assets.

RESIDENCE PERMIT CARACTERISTICS

The **Residence Permit** allows the foreign citizens to legaly live and work in Portugal and grants them rights and obligations.

Expiry: 1 year and renewable for successive periods of 2 years – exceptionally during 2021 the residence permites issued are valid for 2 years and renewable for periods of 3 years.

Renewal deadline: up to thirty days days before residence permit deadline;

Decision Time Limit over the request: 90 days counted from SEF's meeting if all requirements are fulfilled;

Responsible Entities: Portuguese Foreigners and Borders Service (SEF);

FOREIGN CITIZENS HOW TO OBTAIN A RESIDENCY PERMIT

Arrival in Portugal with visa

Schedule SEF's meeting for submission of documentation

Application analysis by the entity

Temporary Residence Permit issuance

Before proceeding with the scheduling, the applicant as to confirm the need to move along with the procedure Following the delivery of the documentation the Residency Permit must be issued within 90 days

Date scheduled for the meeting may exceed visa deadline

The documents required for the residency permit application are:

- Passport;
- Valid residency visa;
- · Proof of accommodation;
- Proof of means of subsistence
- Request for criminal record enquiry by the Immigration and Border Services (SEF);
- Supporting document with the necessary information for checking the registration within tax authority;
- Supporting document with the necessary information for checking social security registration;
- Health insurance or Portuguese Healthcare System registration;

At their discretion, SEF may request for additional documents or clarifications.



Additionally to the previously referred documents, for each specific residency permit the apllicant should also presente:

Employed Workers

- · Work contract under the law in force;
- Supporting document with the necessary information for checking the regular payment of social security;

Self - Employed Workers

- · Evidence of a Company owned by the applicant incorporation; or
- · Service contract with a company as a liberal professional; or
- Supporting document with the necessary information for checking the registration within tax authority as a self-employed;

Retired people or people living out of individual revenue

- · Retirement proof; or
- Proof of the revenue from movable and immovable property; intellectual or financial assets;



FAMILY REUNIFICATION

HOW TO APPLY FOR FAMILY REUNIFICATION

Schedule SEF's meeting by the holder of the right for family reunification to submit the documents

> (Art.º 98.º/n.º1 Lei n.º 23/2007 ou Art.º 15.º Lei n.º 37/2006)

Considering that family reunification was not required together with the visa and the family member to reunify is abroad

SEF informs
the applicant about the
decision

Informs the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to start the process of residence visa with competent consular post

Submit family reunification visa application (Art.º 64.º Lei n.º 23/2007)

To be presented by the member of the family to reunify at the competent consular post

Residency Permit for family reunification

(Art.º 107.º Lei n.º 23/2007 ou Art.º 98.º/n.º2 Lei n.º 23/2007)

When holding the visa, the family member is authorized to legally enter in Portugal to submit its family reunification permit application

In case the family member to reunify is already legally in Portugal, as its entry does not depend on a visa, the applicant must waive previous steps



The **application** for **family reunification** is submitted by the holder of the right to family reunification at SEF and is only applicable when the family member to reunify is abroad.

Are entitled to **family reunification**, by reference to the holder of the right to family reunification:

- The spouse;
- Underage or incapacitated children;
- Children who are of age and study in a Portuguese teaching institution;
- Parents of the applicant or the respective spouse provided they are dependent on either of them;
- Underage siblings, provided they are dependent on the applicant;
- Civil partner provided the union is legally recognized.



Documents:

- Documentary proof certifying the entitlement to Family Reunification;
- Authenticated copies of the identification documents of the applicant's family members;
- Proof of accommodation;
- Proof of means of subsistence
- Extract from the judicial record in the country of origin or of provenance of the family member;

Decision Time Limit over the request: 30 days;

Responsible Entities: Portuguese Foreigners and Borders Service (SEF);

The visa for family reunification request depends on the application for family reunification being aproved by SEF.

Following, the family member shall present themself at the competente consular post in order to require for the visa for family reunification purposes.

Valid for a period of: 4 mounts (with two authorized entrances in Portugal) – the entrances number shall be confirmed in the visa;

Decision Time Limit over the request 60 days;

Responsible Entities: the Portuguese consular post of the respective area of residence (when applicable);

Documents:

- · Official request form;
- Passport;
- Two passport photos, up-to-date and with enough quality to identify the applicant;
- Valid travel insurance, allowing medical coverage, including medical emergencies and repatriation;
- Proof of being in a regular situation when from a different nationality than that of the country where the visa is being applied for;
- Request for criminal record enquiry by the Immigration and Border Services (SEF);
- Criminal record certificate from the country of origin or the country where the applicant is residing for over a year;
- Proof of accommodation;
- · Proof of means of subsistence;
- Notification of approval of family reunification provided by SEF;
- · Authenticated supporting documents proving the family links invoked

At their discretion, the consular post may request for additional documents or clarifications.

The **Residence Permit for family reunification** allows its holder, following the issuance of the visa, or in particular cases without the need for a visa, to live legally in Portugal in order to be with the family member that is already legally in the country.

Valid for a period of: the same as the family member entitled to family reunification;

Renewal deadline: up to thirty days days before residence permit deadline;

Decision Time Limit over the request: 90 days counted from SEF's meeting if all requirments are fulfilled;

Entity responsible for the service: Portuguese Foreigners and Borders Service (SEF);

In case of a **Residence Permit for a family member who is already legally in Portugal**, because he/she comes from a country that does not require a visa, the following documents must be attached to the Residency Permit request:

- Documentary proof certifying the entitlement to Family Reunification;
- Passport original and a copy;
- Proof of accommodation;
- Proof of means of subsistence
- Extract from the judicial record in the country of origin or of provenance of the family member;
- Criminal record certificate from the country of origin or the country where the applicant is residing for over a year;
- · Authenticated supporting documents proving the family links invoked;
- Proof of legal entrance in national territory;



FEES

Residency Visa

90€;

In situations where visa applications are filed with a partner entity of the consular post, a fee charged by these entities will be added to this amount.

Residency Permit

- 83,30€ request reception and analysis;
- 72,20€ for each temporary recidence permit;
- 39,10€ forms and stickers;
- 8,70€ residency permit mailing;
